We invite application from students of your university/institute/college with good academic background pursuing the post-graduate degree in economics, management, agriculture and related disciplines. The students who have completed first year of post-graduation studies and are interested in associating with NABARD for Summer Internship Scheme 2015-16 during April to August 2015 may apply to NABARD through their affiliated institute/universities. The selected students will be paid a limited stipend during the period of the assignment i.e. 8-12 weeks (max 3 months). However, it may be noted that this offer of NABARD Student Internship Scheme 2015-16 does not confer any right on employment in NABARD whatsoever.

2. The students selected for the scheme will be required to undertake a study and submit a report on select theme assigned to them. The Salient features of the scheme are given in Annexure. The detail can be accessed on our website (www.nabard.org)

Annexure - I

Guidelines – NABARD Student Internship Scheme - 2015-16

The objective of the Scheme is to assign task/projects, useful and relevant to NABARD, to talented students pursuing the post-graduate Degree in Agriculture, Agri-business, Economics, Social Sciences and Management from Institute/University/ college of repute. The scheme would also provide feedback with a fresh perspective through studies/projects undertaken by the students on the selected themes of interest to NABARD.

(A) Theme for Student Internship Scheme for 2015-16

(i) The student selected for the scheme may have to undertake field visits for collecting data/information on the theme as advertised on our website (www.nabard.org). The main theme of SIS are Sources of finance for production and investment needs: understanding the cash flow pattern of various categories of farmers, Issues in Micro-insurance, Productivity differential on own land and leased-in land, Effect of recapitalization on performance of PACS, Issues in Financial Intermediation through SHG federation, Study on role of Joint Liability groups in livelihood support to rural poor

(B). Criteria and procedure for selection of the students:

(i) Students (who have completed first year of post-graduation studies) pursuing courses in Agriculture, Agri-business, Economics, Social Studies and Management with good academic background from Institute/University of repute.

(ii) Based on the bio data having good academic record, eligible students would be short listed for interview. Based on the academic qualification, aptitude and interest of the student and the requirement of NABARD, three students will be selected for internship.

(c) Financial Support from NABARD to Summer Interns:

3. The financial benefits approved for implementation of the scheme are as under:

(i) The selected students will be paid a consolidated stipend of Rs. 12,500/- per month during the entire period of the assignment i.e. 8-12 weeks (max. 3 months).

(ii) Field visit allowance of Rs. 1000/- per day inclusive of all expenses towards lodging, boarding, local conveyance etc. (during the actual period of field visit subject to a maximum of 30 days) and local allowances for visit to Govt. offices/Banks/agencies for collection of data/information within Head Quarter @ Rs. 300/- per day (max. 15 days).

(iii) The travel expenses by AC III tier/Bus fare for joining at Regional office and for the field visit and return is to be reimbursed to the student on actual basis. Wherever AC III tier is not available, AC II tier may be permitted. The interns will have to make their Boarding and lodging arrangements for their stay at NABARD HQ i.e. Ahmedabad during the internship period.

4. The interns will have to give an undertaking to NABARD to the effect that he/she will have no right/claim on the report submitted by him/her to the Bank after completion of the assignment except submission to his/her university/institute and the Bank shall be free to use the same in the manner considered appropriate by it.

5. The interns will also be required to give a declaration that he/she will maintain complete secrecy and shall not use for any other purpose any information of confidential nature that might come to his/her knowledge during the period of assignment under the Scheme.

6. However, It may be noted that this offer of NABARD Student Internship Scheme 2015-16 does not confer any right on employment in NABARD whatsoever.
