INST' payable at Navsari with required documents should be submitted to the office of The Principal, ASPEE Agribusiness Management Institute, Dandi Road, NAU, Navsari, 396 450. Last date for receiving completed application form is 11<sup>th</sup> August 2017.

## INTAKE CAPACITY

A total of 37 students will be admitted. (28 GSAU's seats, 9 ICAR seats)

# ELIGIBILITY

Four year Bachelor degree prorgamme offered by AU's in Agriculture and all allied sciences viz. Agriculture / Horticulture /Forestry /Veterinary / Fisheries/ Agricultural Information Technology / Agricultural engineering/ Dairy science / Food science and technology / Agricultural Biotechnology / Home science etc. with minimum 55% marks (OGPA 5.5/10.00).

# SELECTION PROCEDURE

The students seeking admission will have to appear in the **Entrance test conducted by NAU, Navsari.** The merit list will be prepared by giving **50: 50** weightage to the OGPA (percentage marks) of the last degree and Entrance test examination.

The separate merit list will be prepared for students.

- 1. Domicile of Gujarat and pass out from SAU's/AU's.
- 2. Non domicile of Gujarat and pass out of SAU's of Gujarat

All the post graduate seats (except ICAR Quota) may be filled up from the students of domicile of Gujarat, but if seats remain vacant from students of Gujarat origin, such vacant seats may be filled up by the candidates of other states who passed their degree from SAUs of Gujarat.

• Eligible applicants shall have to appear for the entrance test at their own cost.

## ENTRANCE TEST

Entrance test will of duration of One hour and Total 100 marks. Multiple choice questions from the sections of General awareness and Agriculture, Verbal comprehension, Logical reasoning, Quantitative aptitude and Data interpretation will be included. Each question will carry one mark. Candidates are instructed to bring black ball point pen for marking answer on OMR answer sheet.

#### **RESERVATION OF SEATS:**

#### **General Conditions regarding Reservation**

A candidate availing benefit of seats earmarked for the categories shall be required to produce the certificate of his belonging to a particular group i.e. ST/SC/SEBC etc., from competent authority of Gujarat State. The candidates belonging to SEBC should produce the certificate showing that he/she does not belong to creamy layer person or section, issued by the competent authority of the Gujarat State valid for the current year otherwise he/she will not be considered against reserved seats for SEBC category.

Those candidates who are able to secure admission on general merit shall not, however, be counted against the seat reserved for them. If the need arises on account of vacant seats due to less number of applications in one group and shortage of seats due to more number of application of eligible candidates in the other group, reciprocal adjustment in the above specified SC (7 %) and ST (15 %) seats between the two groups will be made. If applications from backward class candidates are more than the reserved seats earmarked for them as above, admission will be given to them strictly on *inter se* merit within each of the only two groups.
