The KVK has been charged now to take up the responsibilities of technology evaluation and impact assessment, demonstration of technology on the farmer's field and update of the knowledge and skill for the farmers.

Mandate:

- ♣ Conducting "On Farm Testing" for identifying technologies in terms of location specific sustainable land used system.
- → Organize the training to update the extension personnel with emerging advances in agricultural research on regular basis.
- ♣ Organize short and long term vocational training course in agricultural and allied vocations for the farmers and rural youth's with emphasis on "learning by doing" for higher production on farm and self-employment.
- → Organize Front Line Demonstrations (FLDs) on various crops to generate production data and feedback information.
