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Preamble

It is very well said that a good photograph is worth thousand words. With intent to enhance skills of the students of the university, Navsari Agricultural University started a Certificate Course in Nature and Wildlife Photography in 2013 under the aegis of ASPEE College of Horticulture and Forestry. Though photography is art of painting with light, many genres are so intrinsically connected with fundamental developments of human life and it has considerably enhancing values through various forms of photography. With a will to learn photography time after time, one needs to be indulged into it austerely. Great photographs are made, not just taken. Though one can self learn about the core techniques of photography, a mentor can expedite the process and during this process a continuous guidance is more important than mere information. This was one of the main reasons of designing a year long course than a short term of couple of weeks. The process of learning about photography and executing it on field takes due time. It invariably varies with person to person, but a year was found suitable to give adequate time to learn, assimilate and implement. The initial idea of designing this course was to improve the quality of photographs the students used in their academic assignments, dissertations and theses. The thought was to start with five to ten students who are sincere about coming every week and ready to devote some time out of their day to day schedule. But the first course registration rushed with sixty eight applications impelling us to widen the horizon. The intake was increased, the batches were doubled and everything was rethought and restructured. After deliberate discussions we decided to go for the number of batches we can unarguably manage and decided on having two batches. For the last four years we have been successfully managing two batches and seventy-two students have been certified through this process. In the years to come the expansion is certainly wished; however quality of teaching and amiable ambiance for learning shall be a priority.

Objectives

- To creates opportunities to work in the field of nature and wildlife photo-journalism.
- To empower agriculture manpower to organize better photographic documentation of their fields of discipline for classroom presentations and other records.
- To creates opportunities to earn by preparing photo-assignments for renowned nature and wildlife photo magazines and books.
- To promote and inculcate the values of art in the age of science, technology and mass media.

With above objectives this course was started benefiting to the students of NAU as the stakeholders, however, over a very short span, the realization of expansion of the course to the general public and all those who are keen to conserve environment and wildlife ensued. As it was designed as weekend classes there was a huge rush to join the course since its inception.

What young students get

- Authorizes students with University approved certificate.
- Creates opportunities for Self-employment.
- Creates opportunities to work as photographers for TV channels and other public media.
- Endows with an insight to look the surrounding with a creative eye.
- Recreates and relaxes in monotonous and hustling way of day-to-day life-style.
- Cultivates hobby for living life with an aesthetic perspective.

In this course we have preferred to have all the multimedia lessons, discussions and critique on a large LCD display for precise understanding of light, colors and contrast. Students are guided not only for nature and wildlife photography, but in all other popular genre so that they can gain confidence and work in any given field. The course is designed in three parts

- 1. Understanding the camera to capture the ideal light and a perfect moment
- 2. The art of seeing and making of images
- 3. Post-processing to enhance visual impact and some practical applications

After every class, the students get exposure to the campus of the university which is full of floral and faunal diversity for the photographers to experiment, practice and light regulation in varied conditions. We also arrange field trips to provide the students practical opportunities do some thematic work and sharpen their skills and catch up with the missed lessons. The best part is critiques, where the students are insisted to upload their weekly work on Flickr website, so that we can browse their work post comments and they can read the critique and participate in the discussion on the page of the course on Flickr.

Amenities created

In a very short period before starting the course we created a lab, bought couple of equipments and managed accessories required for smooth functioning of the course. So far we have developed a well-equipped laboratory, studio with external flash lights for indoor photo-work, computer lab, cameras for in-house practice, photo cybrary, tripods and other required accessories.

Class Strength

This is another important factor and honestly we did churn our brains much for deciding the number of students per batch. When it is just to deliver lectures and there can be any number of students a teacher can address but when it is intrinsic areas like teaching and developing art like photography a deep communication, sometimes even beyond words and gestures, is needed. This can only be possible with fewer numbers of students at a time. Along with this, a group psychology is very important in the process of learning. One to one learning has different dimension while researches show that group learning is more attentive and more participatory. Therefore, there should be a balanced number which can satisfy both, a teacher and student. After taking into considerations of the infrastructure available and all above factors we decided to have ten to twelve students in a batch. So far students in one batch.

Upload and critique forum – Flickr

It is insisted that the students attend all the sessions, work on the given assignments and upload their work for critique to get maximum benefits. One can clearly see the progress of the students who are sincere with class attendance and homework, on the Flickr website. Each photograph uploaded by students is critically examined and commented on at what area student has to develop himself or how a simple alternation of his position or camera angle could have made image litter more impactful. The students here find joy of learning in a positive environment consisting of likeminded people.

Course duration

The duration is kept of one year so that the student gets enough time to understand, experiment, practice and grow with time. The course starts by Aug and ends in July followed by an exhibition of the best images of students. Generally, the classes are every Saturday for two hours which leads to around forty to forty five sessions a year.

Field Trips

Minimum three outdoor field trips are conducted for practical training and thematic work. This thematic work is considered as assignment and it is graded which are counted in overall result of the course. This Thematic work is considered as assignments and holds a percentage of over all grades.

Eligibility

All photography enthusiasts who has at least completed matriculation and is above 18 years is eligible for the course. We do give preference in selection to the applicant who has a little experience in photography, who is really passionate about photography and to the ones who are genuinely interested in sharpening their skills through this course. NAU staff, students and alumni are given preference over others if found compatible.

Fee Structure

This is probable one of the cheapest courses being offered in the country in the field of photography. Ironically a week workshop cost is taken as one year fees. In addition to this a special fee is worked out for students of the university and other bonafied students with an objective to train youth towards developing their skill in the field of photography which is a step forward towards skill India.
