Gender Harassment-cum-Women Development Cell

On 13th August 1997, the Supreme Court of India held that sexual harassment of women is a violation of the fundamental right of women to work in a safe environment. Often such behavior goes unpunished because of hesitation on the part of women to report such behavior out of a sense of shame or fear or both. It is important for women to protest against any behavior that they feel is unwanted and unacceptable. The Gender Harassment Committee has been set up with the aim of providing women appropriate complaint mechanism against unwelcome sexually determined behavior whether directly or by implication. Thus, the following members of Gender Harassment cum Women Development Cell Committee would deal with the complaints of gender harassment by students, academic and non-academic staff in this institution, in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the Supreme Court of India relating to sexual harassment of women workers at work places and students.
