- ETG currently trades in *Maize, Wheat, Soya Beans, Rice, Sorghum, Millet, Beans, Pigeon Peas, Cow Peas, Chick Peas, Green Gram, Groundnuts, Cashew Nuts, Sesame Seed, Niger Seeds, Coriander Seeds, Cumin Seeds, Linseed, Ginger, Cloves, Sugar, Coffee, Tea and Fertilizer.* Maize constitutes to be the largest commodity by volume.
- ETG currently has **26 such plants operating in Africa and Asia,** transforming maize, rice, cashew nuts, wheat, pulses, soybeans, sesame seeds, coffee and fertilizer into marketable products for regional and international distribution. ***Over the last decade, ETG has invested over US\$150m along the supply chain to enhance and develop the commercial capabilities of the continent.*** ETG has assembled a prominent infrastructure which includes the following:
