Faculty: Agriculture/ Horticulture & Forestry/Agriculture Engineering & Technology/ Agricultural Engineering/ Renewable Energy & Environmental Engineering/Agribusiness Management/ Human Resource Development.

Prescribed Qualifications:

- a) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level in a relevant subject of the concerned faculty from an Indian University.
- b) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR/ICAR/ similar test conducted by the State Government and should have published at least one article in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Science, New Delhi) rated journal.

For the candidate having Master's degree, NET shall remain compulsory along with one publication in NAAS rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted by ICAR/UGC/CSIR. Essentiality of NET can be waived off for the candidates holding Ph.D degree provided it has been done with course work and research work prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009 and the candidate has at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.

Desirable:

d) Possess the basic knowledge of computer application equivalent to course on computer concepts (CCC⁺) of Department of Electronic Accreditation of Computer Courses (DOEACC) society or of the level as may be prescribed by Government from time to time.

Relaxation:

- a) NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such subjects for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted
- b) For the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment, a relaxation of 5% at the *Graduate and Master's* level for the SC/ST/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories of the candidates.
- c) The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks excluding grace marks if any.
- d) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D degree holders, who have obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.

Maximum Age Limit: Below 35 Years

i) Age relaxable in suitable cases of the employees of the Gujarat Agricultural Universities.
