**Sub: International training on Regional Plant Health Systems Analysis - Reg.**

*Dear Sir / Madam,*

International trade of plants and plant products has witnessed several fold increase in the post WTO era. A number of International Agreements/Treaties/ Conventions have emerged in the past decade to harmonize various factors/ issues associated with International Trade. The understanding of a country's Plant Health System (PHS) in the context of various international Agreements, Conventions and Treaties has therefore become necessary. The analysis of Plant Health Systems thus in the context of above gives an opportunity to critically review their existing systems and will give insights on the dual objectives viz. (i) Status on safeguarding the National biosecurity and (ii) Preparedness in the backdrop of global requirements for market access.

A special programme on Regional Plant Health Systems Analysis is scheduled from 23.11.2015 - 07.12.2015 at NIPHM in collaboration with USDA-APHIS. Further, expert faculty from IPPC, FAO Rome will also deliver lectures during the programme. The programme is targeted for senior/middle level extension officers from State Department of Agriculture/Horticulture, Research and Teaching faculty from State Agricultural Universities and ICAR Institutes. Nomination may be forwarded to NIPHM before 9th November, 2015. The selected participants will be provided with free lodging & boarding in the campus and reimbursement of travel expenses. The reimbursement of travel expenses will be subjected to shortest route from place of posting to NIPHM and back, for the entitled class but restricted to II-tier AC rail fare on the production of **original tickets / vouchers**.
