Venue of the Conference:

Navsari is located near the bank of Purna river around 40 kms from Surat towards Mumbai on National highway number 8. Geographically, it is situated at longitude 72° 54' East and latitude 20° 57' North. The height from the mean sea level is 11.89 M. Navsari comes under South Gujarat heavy rainfall zone and Agro-ecologcal situation (AES) III. The climate is sub humid with maximum temperature ranges from 27.9 °C to 34.9 °C and minimum from 12.2 °C to 24.2 °C with mean annual rainfall of 1133.6 mm spread over 95 rainy days. Weather during January is pleasant in Navsari and temperature ranges between 12 to 24 °C with relative humidity around 45 per cent.

Connectivity:

The nearest local airport is at Surat, 40 km north of Navsari, with the nearest international airports being Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport at Mumbai, 260 kms to the south and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport, Ahmedabad, 270 kms to the north. By Rail: Navsari also lies on the Mumbai-Delhi railway link, one of the busiest railway routes in India. By Road: Navsari is well connected by NH 228 also known as Sabarmati-Dandi Highway. NH 8 also passes near the city. Navsari is only 40 kms south of Surat and has one of the best road connectivity in India.

The abstract should contain brief introduction, objective, methods, results and conclusion within 250 words typed in 1.5 space, Times New Roman font in MS word only. Presenting authors name should be underlined, affiliation should be in italics, with email address of the presenter. Title should be in 14 font. Remaining all the materials should be in 12 font.
