1) Background information on the project and the assignment	The Organization: Navsari Agricultural University, a state agricultural university was established in the year 2004 with the enactment of Act No. 5 of 2004 (Gujarat Agricultural Universities Act, 2004) and mandated to work in the field of higher education in different Agriculture and allied sciences like Agriculture, Horticulture, Forestry, Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry, Agribusiness Management, Agricultural Engineering Food Processing Technology, Biotechnology, Fisheries etc.; as well as contribute in the location specific research in agricultural field and also act as a nodal agency for the extension of developed technologies to the end users such as farmers, consumers, entrepreneurs etc. The Project: Indian Council of Agricultural research is the premier body working under Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmer Welfare, Government of India (GoI) which is handling core issue of regulation and development basic and higher education, research and extension activities in agriculture and allied field. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) in collaboration with the World Bank has enunciated a series of projects to revamp the national research, extension and innovation systems. The National Agricultural Higher Education			
	Project has been conceived to enable the agricultural education system catch up nationally and internationally with the peers. This project is aimed at enhancing the capability of best of the agricultural universities in the country (like the DUs in the ICAR system) to become globally relevant and competitive by investing in chosen core activities that have a bearing on their reckoning to be counted in the race. This project has several components and subcomponents. However, Navsari Agricultural University had obtained a project entitled "Establishment of Secondary Agriculture Unit for Skill Development in Students and Farmers at NAU, Navsari" in subcomponent Investments in Centres for Advanced Agricultural Science and Technology (CAAST) on June 13, 2018. The objectives of this project are to acquaint PG students, faculty members and technical project staff with latest technologies in different spheres of secondary agriculture, capacity building, competency development, product development and its commercialization. This project shall focus on Processing and Waste Utilization in Horticultural Produce; Scientific Utilization of Non-Timber Forest Products and Medicinal and Aromatic Plants, Establishment of Small Scale Climate Resilient Dairy Unit and Pesticide Residue Analysis from agricultural and other food commodities. Background for Consultancy: India has attained global supremacy in the production of horticultural produce, occupying the first and second positions in world, respectively. Gujarat is one of the ecologically important states in the country and composed of tropical fruit crops. In, Gujarat, Southern belt of the Gujarat is known for horticultural			

crops especially for mango, banana, sapota, potatoes, okra, brinjal and carrots. Owing to highly perishable nature; fruits, vegetables and flowers have very short shelf-life resulting 25-33% post harvest loss accounting monetary loss of around Rs 65,000 crores. These losses can only be minimized by proper handling, marketing and processing of the agricultural commodities. For preventing these losses, State Agricultural Universities, ICAR and Ministry of Food Processing are playing a pivotal role. Despite meager processing (<2.4%), the food processing industry ranks fifth in size in the country and employs more than 16 lakh workers which is 19% of the country's industrial labour. It accounts for 14% of the total industrial output with 18% of industrial GDP and 6.3% of countries GDP. There are around 6878 cold storage units and 36974 food processing units in India; out of which 625 cold storage units and 1924 food processing units are in Gujarat state.

In Gujarat, mango fruits are being processed mostly in the form of pulp in different processing industry while banana is processed in the form of wafers only and is being sold in domestic and international markets. However, scientific utilization of mango processing industry waste and further value addition of the mango pulp is lacking with respect to processing of mango at industrial level and even at grower levels. Therefore, there is a need of awareness and skill development among this group regarding sustainable harvesting, utilization and processing of mango fruits to augment the income of the farming communities and entrepreneurers. This proposed work shall focus on collection, processing, grading and commercial valuation of product including marketing features pertaining to mango processing. Skill and technology developed through this programme would help in sustainable harvesting and processing, diversified value addition of mango and banana in South Gujarat condition. The expert of consultant shall provide technical information pertaining to mango processing, diversification of mango and banana products and marketing feasibility of the value added products.

The expenditure/financing for the consultancy/assignment will be made from the CAAST sub-project.

2) Precise statement of the objectives of assignment

The CAAST sub-project seeks advisory services from individual (s) that fulfil the following objectives:

The proposed sub-project shall focus on following aspects in which our PG students and faculty members must trained and able to deliver and carry out further entrepreneurship by the PG students and planning out of research by the scientists and dissemination of technologies to various stake holders like farmers, forest staff including students and industrialists.

Main objectives

- To impart orientation for project formulation to establish processing Unit.
- To impart training on processing, value addition and waste utilization of horticultural produce for development of entrepreneurship skills in students for self-employment.
- Testing of the developed technologies and TOT for commercialization at pilot scale to build confidence in students through professional skills.
- To provide hands on onsite and offsite training of state of art sophisticated instruments and techniques relevant to processing and value addition of mango and banana to students and faculties of agricultural university.
- To facilitate for development of linkage and working relation for sharing the expertise, infrastructure and technical knowhow related to legal matters related to setting of industries
- To provide guidance in framing R&D work concurrent to contemporary world as well as the new frontiers in processing and value addition of mango and banana in lieu of R&D need.

3) An outline of the tasks to be carried out (Scope of services) including transfer of knowledge, if any

The consultant have to support and provide the guidance to CAAST sub-project: The proposed objective covers the following activities:

- Demand and supply feasibility report shall be prepared for new value added products including functional foods in the market prepared from mango and banana
- ii) Infrastructure and capital requirement for setting up of the processing industry
- iii) Assessment shall be made on the feasibility for setting of the processing industry by the entrepreneurs.
- iv) Feasibility shall be studied for the export quality of the processed products
- v) Pilot scale testing and feasibility report shall be worked out for the validation of developed products
- vi) IPR and its management procedures shall be prepared
- vii) Business plan: Technical, financial and market analysis
- viii) Process and formalities required (documentary proofs) for setting up of a new venture including registration, licensing *etc*.
- ix) Guidelines for setting up MSME and incubator centres.
- x) The agency will provide the separate list of Trader with addresses, Phone number for the requirement of primary processed raw material consumption.
- xi) Instruments/machinery required processing
- xii) Precaution to be taken in during the processing activities

4) Schedule for completion of tasks:

Most of the work related this sub-project will be done at NAU, Campus however for certain specific works the consultant may have to go the other part of the Gujarat or other parts of India.

- **Duration and Length of the Assignment**: The Initial contract period of the assignment will be start from February 01, 2019 till March 31, 2019. However, the length of contract period will be subjected to expansion. But it is based on discretion of committee of NAU.
- Financing and Payment Schedule: The assignment will be financed under CAAST sub-project entitled "Establishment of Secondary Agriculture Unit for Skill Development in Students and Farmers at NAU, Navsari" under National Agricultural Higher Education Project. The payment will be made in two installment based upon submission and approval of the final report related with all deliverables. This Contract shall come into effect on the date the Contract is signed by both Parties or such other later date as may be stated in the TOR.
- The Consultant shall begin to carrying out the Services not later than the number of days after the Effective Date stated in TOR.
- Unless terminated earlier, Contract shall expire at the Effective Date as specified in the TOR.

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B.1) Extension of Time

Any period within which a Party shall, pursuant to this Contract, complete any action or task, shall be extended for a period equal to the time during which such Party was unable to perform such action as a result of *Force Majeure*.

B.2) Payments

During the period of their inability to perform the Services as a result of an event of *Force Majeure*, the Consultant shall be entitled to continue to be paid under the terms of this Contract, as well as to be reimbursed for additional costs reasonably and necessarily incurred by them during such period for the purposes of the Services and in reactivating the Service after the end of such period.

C)Termination

C.1) Termination by the Client

The Client may terminate this Contract in case of the occurrence of any of the events specified in following paragraphs

- (a) If the consultant does not remedy a failure in the performance of their obligations under the contract, within thirty (30) days after being notified or within any further period as the client may have subsequently approved in writing.
- (b) If the consultant becomes insolvent or bankrupt.
- (c) If the consultant, in the judgment of the Client has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- (d) If, as the result of *Force Majeure*, the Consultant are unable to perform a material portion of the Services for a period of not less than sixty (60) days.
- (e) If the client, in its sole discretion and for any reason whatsoever, decides to terminate this contract.

C.2) Termination by the Consultant

- The Consultants may terminate this contract, by not less than thirty (30) days' written notice to the client, such notice to be given after the occurrence of any of the events specified in following paragraphs
- (a) If the client fails to pay any money due to the consultant pursuant to this Contract.
- (b) If as the result of *Force Majeure*, the consultant is unable to perform a material portion of the services for a period of not less than sixty (60) days.
- (c) If the client fails to comply with any final decision reached as a result of arbitration.

C.3) Payment upon Termination

Upon termination of this Contract the Client shall make the following payments to the Consultant:

(a) payment for services satisfactorily performed only prior to the effective date of termination

D) Conflict of Interests

The consultant shall hold the client's interests paramount, without any consideration for future work, and strictly avoid conflict with other assignments or their own corporate interests. the consultant shall not accept for their own benefit any trade commission, discount, or similar payment in connection with activities pursuant to this contract or to the services or in the discharge of their obligations under the contract, and the consultant shall use their best efforts to ensure that the personnel, any sub-consultants, and agents of either of them similarly shall not receive any such additional payment. The consultant shall not engage, and shall cause their personnel as well as their sub-consultants and their personnel not to engage, either directly or indirectly, in any business or professional activities which would conflict with the activities assigned to them under this contract.

E) Confidentiality

Except with the prior written consent of the client, the consultant and the personnel shall not at any time communicate to any person or entity any confidential information acquired in the course of the services, nor shall the consultant and the personnel make public the recommendations formulated in the course of, or as a result of, the Services.

F) IPR and Publication

All IPR and publication rights will remain with the client only. The consultant will not claim any IPR and will not publish any report/findings etc. in any form without prior permission of the client.

G) Arbitration

- It is hereby agreed between the two Parties that TOR shall be executed in manner and form outlined in this Agreement. Any dispute, controversy, difference of any kind whatsoever or claim arising out of or in relation to this Agreement, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be settled amicably by negotiation between the Parties. If no amicable resolution or settlement is reached within a period of thirty (30) days from date on which above-mentioned dispute or difference arose, such dispute or difference shall be referred to an Arbitrator, appointed by mutual consent of both the Parties herein.
- If the Parties cannot agree on the appointment of an Arbitrator within a period of two months from the notification by the party to the other of existence of such dispute, then the Arbitrator shall be appointed by NAU-Navsari.
- The seat of arbitration shall be Navsari and arbitration shall be conducted in English language
- The arbitration will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act of 1996, or of any modifications or reenactments thereof.
- The arbitral award will be final and binding, subject to legal remedies available under the law.
- Existence of any dispute or difference or initiation or continuance of arbitral proceedings shall not postpone or delay performance by Parties of their respective obligations under or pursuant to this Agreement. Further, this Agreement shall remain subsisting and operative during the arbitral proceedings and no payment due and payable to either Party shall be withheld except payment in dispute, if any.
- This Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the prevailing laws of India.
