He explained the participants about the likely questions, ideal answers, the dynamics of projecting professional body language, power dressing for success and such other issues.

In the concluding half-an-hour, in order to boost the confidence of the students, the trainer used several powerful motivational videos, highlighting the struggles and bouncing-back characteristics of various famous personalities.

Through intensive 8 hours training programme, he stimulated the students' thought processes and cues to make them look at their skills and capabilities in an entirely new light; so that they can win the race in this cut-to-throat competitive job market conditions. By using a mixture of training methodologies like stimulating presentation, various psychological games, role playing and powerful motivational videos, he ensured that students digest the desired inputs in live and interesting atmosphere. In the end, he urged the students to take on some sort of self responsibility for their own career development.
